

## Volunteering For All Workshop

The Volunteering For All workshop introduces young people to the key concepts around volunteerism. This session typically takes 2 hours (120 minutes, to fit into a standardised school timetable). The workshop easily fits with SPHE (including 6th class primary), CSPE, RE, JCSP, Junior Cycle Short Course on Community Action, Wellbeing, TY, LCA, LCVP and Politics and Society.

As part of the workshop your students will:

- Explore their community
- Examine volunteerism
- Appreciate the importance of diversity and difference
- Create a Volunteering For All school charter
- Evaluate their learning
- Be issued with the challenge; to profile and record volunteering in their school
